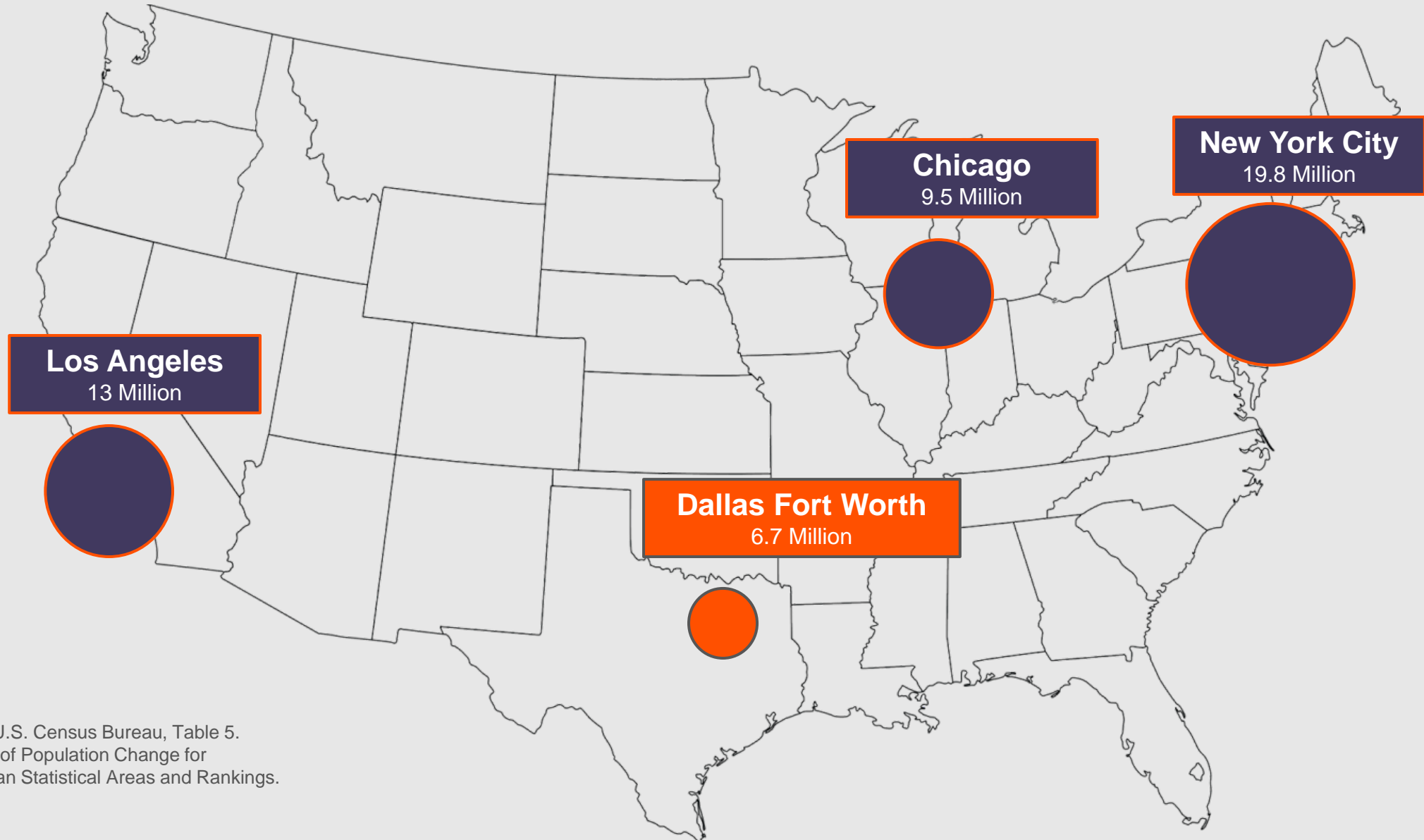

3rd Busiest Airport in the World and Still Growing





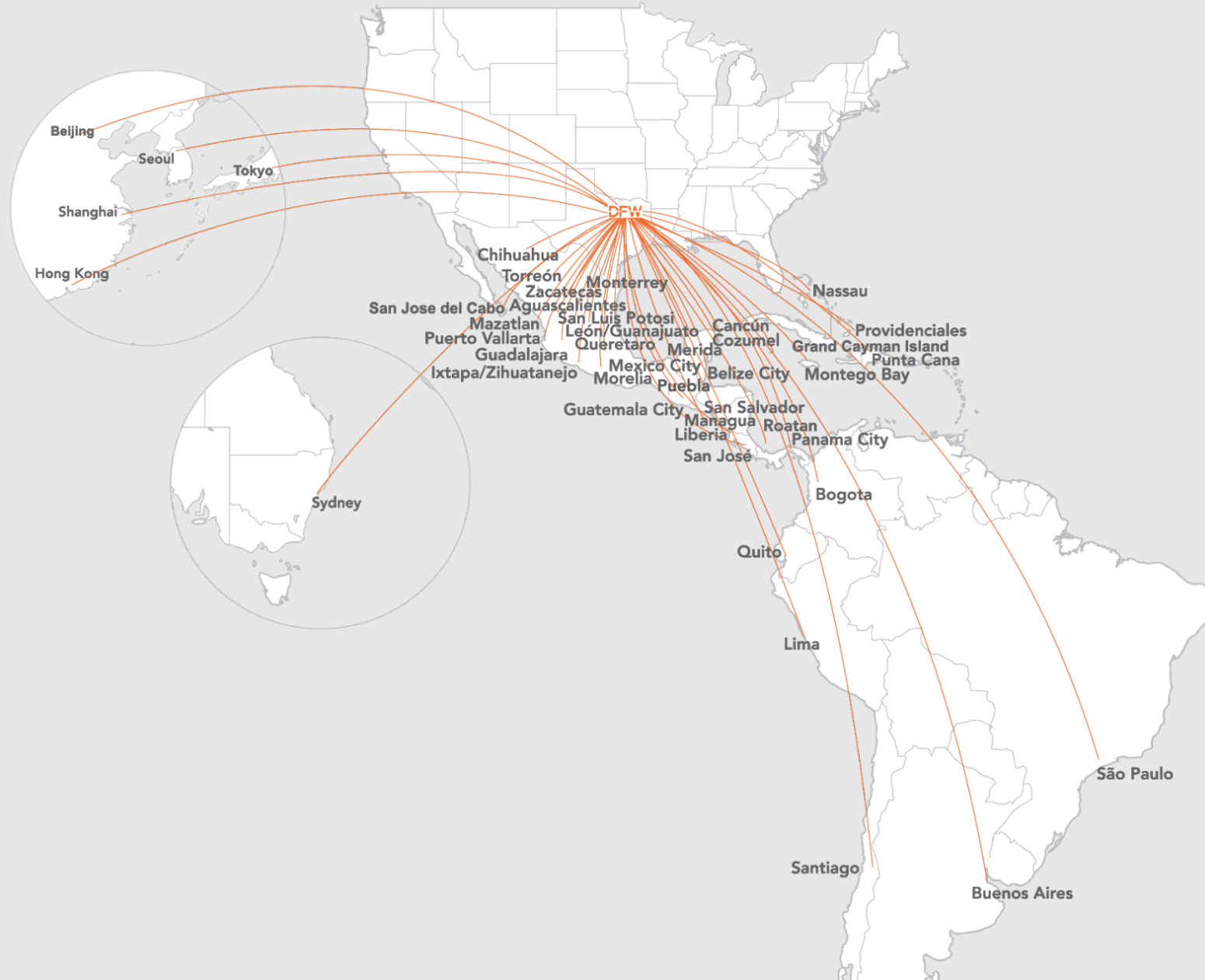

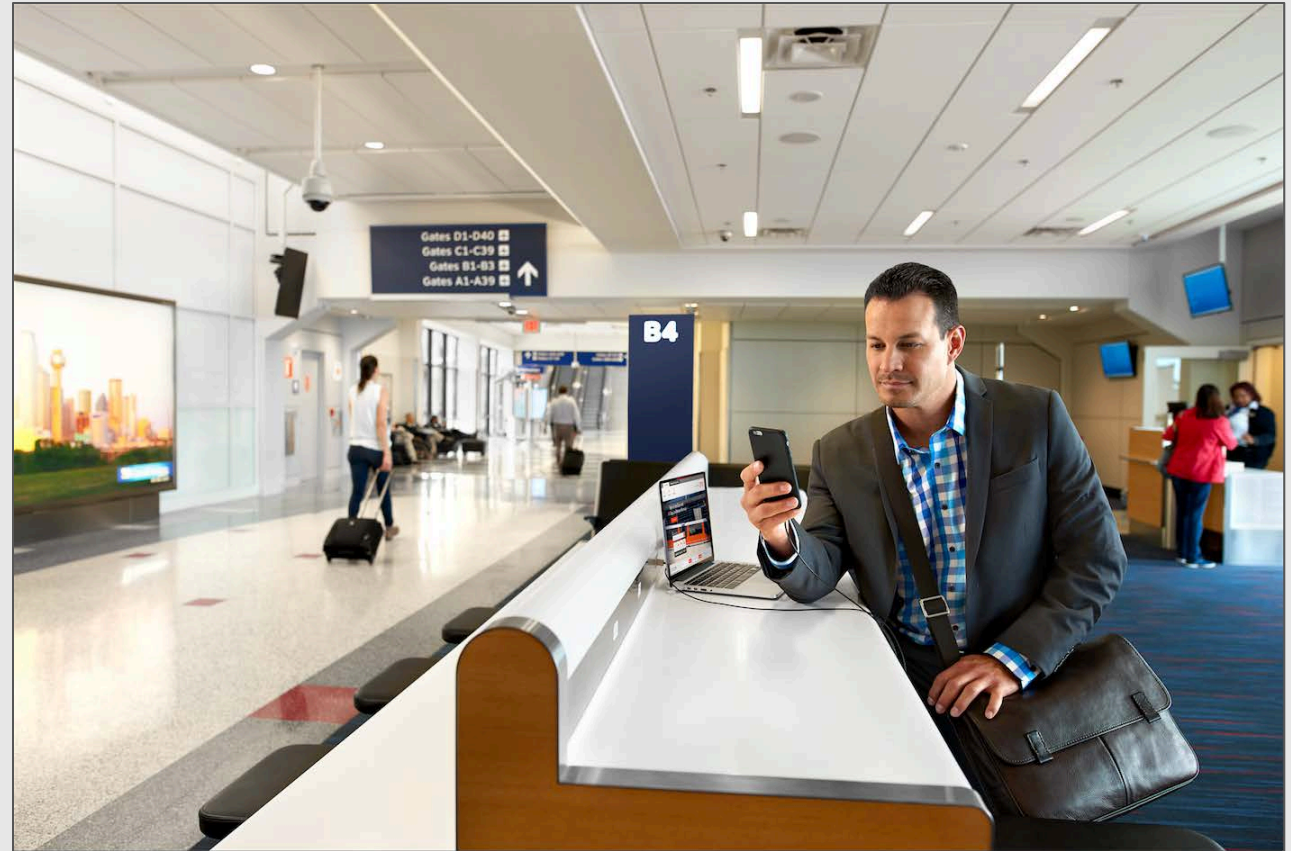
Language Assistance for International Travelers

Skylink Train

Transfer to other terminals inside security

- Two stations in each terminal
- Arriving every 2 minutes
- Trains run both directions
- 5 minute average ride time



Terminal Link

Transfer to other terminals outside security

- Shuttles arrive every 10 minutes
- Free service, no ticket needed
- Two pick-up/drop-off locations at each terminal
